

Ohkay Hotel Casino – Public Statement
Coronavirus/COVID-19
11/13/2020

With the Public Health Order (PHO) amendments due to the Coronavirus/COVID-19 from the State of New Mexico on 11/13/2020 the Tsay Corporation Executive Team has had to react to ensure the health and safety of guests, team members, and outside vendors.

With the increase of cases in our region over the last few weeks the casino has been financially impacted as many guests have chosen to stay away and at home.

With New Mexico State Governor Grisham PHO restricting our employees coming to work and the reduction of revenue from the past few weeks the Executive Team is temporary closing of the Gaming and Bar Operations. The time frame would be **4:00am November 16, 2020 thru 3:59am December 1, 2020 (14 days)**.

The following temporary changes to amenities and operations on the Casino property are:

- Food will have takeaway and curbside offerings.
- Hotel operations are changing as laid out in the Ohkay Hotel Casino Well-Being and Cleanliness Program 11.13.2020.1
- Only business essential employees will report to work.
 - Team members with leave (PTO and/or vacation) would be asked to use this time to stay home; If they do not have paid leave they can use LWOP.

On or before the end of the 14-day temporary closure the Casino property would then re-evaluate to make a decision for returning to normal operations.
