Subj: St. Anthony Activities

Our culture has been on hold for three years and with timeless discussion and deliberation the Cultural Leaders have decided to move forward with activities. Therefore, the Cultural Leaders have decided that Ohkay Owingeh will proceed with dancing the Green Corn (Khoeh'e'yay) on St. Anthony Day, June 13, 2022. Listed are restrictions that must be followed for the well-being of the community in order to maintain a safe environment.

1. EVERYONE will be required to wear a mask.
2. There will be no Kiva Practice.
3. All dancers and singers must show proof of vaccination (vaccination cards)
4. All men helping with the dance must show proof of vaccination. (vaccination cards)
5. Due to safety precautions, children under the age of 10 years old will not be allowed to dance.
6. Kiva area will be reserved for dancers only. Public will not be allowed in this area.
7. No lunch break will be taken (bring your own water and snacks or a lunch).
8. Men show up by 6:00 a.m. for painting (optional); All dancers participation must be outside of the Kiva by 8:00 a.m.
9. Social distance will be enforced, do not engage with the dancers.
10. We recommend that the families not engage in visitor feedings.
11. Only PoPay Avenue main entrance will be open to enter the village.
